FOOD MERCHANT INFORMATION

Greetings,

Ron and I would like to thank you for helping to make the last ten years wonderful and 2007 the best year yet for the Faire. We had over 80,000 patrons over the three weekends with the 2nd one being a true record breaker.

Below you will find your 2009 application. All rules about product sold from last year will apply again this year. There are a few new things that you need to know before filling out the app.

- 1) Due to costs, the price is going up.
- 2) This year <2009> the water will be included in the price instead of being an extra cost.
- 3) If you need ice you **MUST** ask for it and pay for it up front **BEFORE** Faire. If you do not, you will have to make your own arrangements for ice. The Faire will no longer have extra to sell on site.
- 4) All fees must be sent in with your application.
- 5) If you have special requests < like where you will be set up> please note that on your application.
- 6) All merchants must have proof of insurance, naming the Washington Renaissance & Fantasy Faire as an under rider, **prior to setting up** on the first weekend of Faire. Please fax a copy to 253-884-1535 or send to Virginia Marcolli with application.
